



Honoring the '80s guitar scene, Gary Kramer Guitar announces the release of the Custom, a modern day version of a guitar which bore Kramer's name and dominated the guitar world during that era.

The Custom is a double cutaway solid body electric. Its carved alder top, fully bound neck and body, real mother of pearl neck inlays, and ebony fingerboard, are mature enhancements to the original design.

But keeping in tune with original '80s theme the Custom is equipped with a non-recessed, double locking Floyd Rose, the tremolo system that became an irreplaceable tool for many professional musicians during the '80s. A final salute to that era of guitar is given by the slanted 6-to-a-side pointed headstock.

Electronically, two directly mounted humbucking pickups are individually split with push/pull volume and tone pots. When used in combination with the three way toggle switch, the Custom is able to engage 8 unique pickup combinations.

Customs are available in classic black and vintage white. List price is \$1,295 and includes a hardshell case.
